### ORDER CALLING COMMISSIONERS ELECTION

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BRAZORIA DRAINAGE DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR THAT:

Section 1: An election (the "Election") shall be held on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024 ("Election Day"). At the Election there shall be submitted to the duly qualified resident voters of the aforesaid district (the "District") the matter of electing commissioners to Places 1 and 2, respectively, of the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the District.

Section 2: All qualified voters of the District shall be entitled to vote in the Election.

Section 3: The District hereby adopts by number, as its precincts for purposes of the Election, those election precincts established by Brazoria County pursuant to Chapter 42, Texas Election Code, that overlap the District in whole or in part.

Section 4: The District has entered, or will hereafter enter, into written agreement(s) with Brazoria County, Texas, for election services and for the purpose of conducting a joint election with other participating political subdivisions located, in whole or in part, in Brazoria County, Texas, pursuant to Chapter 31 and Chapter 271, Texas Election Code (collectively, the "Joint Election Agreement"). The form(s) of the Joint Election Agreement are hereby approved in all respects. The Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to execute the Joint Election Agreement on behalf of the District. Any prior execution of the Joint Election Agreement by the Chairman of the Board is hereby ratified and approved in all respects.

Section 5: As authorized by Chapter 31 and Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code, and pursuant to the Joint Election Agreement, the Election shall be conducted by Brazoria County, Texas. The District hereby appoints Joyce Hudman, Brazoria County Clerk, to perform or to supervise the performance of any and all of the duties and responsibilities related to the conduct of the Election, as further specified in the Joint Election Agreement.

Section 6: As authorized by Chapter 31 and Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code, and pursuant to the terms of the Joint Election Agreement, the District hereby appoints Joyce Hudman, Brazoria County Clerk, as the Early Voting Clerk for the Election. Early voting by personal appearance for the eligible voters of the District shall be conducted at the locations and on the days and during the times set forth on <a href="Exhibit "A" attached hereto">Exhibit "A"</a>, 1524 East Mulberry, Angleton, Texas 77515 is hereby designated as the main early voting polling place. Applications for voting by mail shall be addressed to the Early Voting Clerk. The official mailing address and contact information of the Early Voting Clerk are as follows:

Section 7: Any eligible voter of the District may vote by personal appearance on Election Day, at the polling locations set forth on Exhibit "B" attached hereto. Voting by personal appearance on Election Day shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., except as provided by Sections 41.032 and 41.033. Texas Election Code.

Section 8: Jennifer Spears is hereby appointed as the District's designated election agent (the "Election Agent") to perform election duties required pursuant to the provisions of Section 31.123, Texas Election Code, and Section 49.109, Texas Water Code. The duration of appointment of such Election Agent shall be from the date hereof until a successor is appointed, and the office hours of such Election Agent shall be from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily, except Saturdays, Sundays or official state holidays. True and correct copies of all documents and materials pertaining to the Election shall be maintained on file in the office of Election Agent at 1300 Post Oak Blvd, Suite 2400, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056 open to inspection by the public or any person interested therein.

Section 9: Names to appear on the ballot for the Election shall be determined in the same manner as a candidate for other county offices, either by becoming the nominee of a political party or by filing as an independent candidate, under the same procedures as a candidate for a precinct office, in accordance with the requirements of Ch. 333 (H.B. 3231), Acts of the 75<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature, Regular Session, 1995 (the "Act").

No person's name shall be placed on the ballot unless he or she meets the qualifications of a Commissioner under the Act and Section 141.001(a), Texas Election Code; and is not otherwise disqualified from holding such office. Joyce Hudman, Brazoria County Clerk is authorized to review filings by candidates and determine the qualifications of candidates for office.

Copies of this Order may be obtained from the Election Agent.

Section 10: Pursuant to Sections 123.001 and 61.012 of the Texas Election Code, as amended, the District hereby adopts for use at the Election the Hart InterCivic Verity Voting System (Version 2.5.3), for voting or early voting by personal appearance, as same has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as an accessible direct recording electronic voting system. In addition, pursuant to Sections 123.006, 63.011 and 125.006, Texas Election Code, the District authorizes the use of paper ballots to the extent necessary in connection with balloting by mail, provisional balloting, or in the event that an emergency prevents the use of the aforesaid direct recording electronic voting systems.

Ballots shall conform to the requirements of the Texas Election Code and be prepared and made available to voters in the English and Spanish languages.

Ballots shall have printed thereon the names of the candidates for the offices of commissioner, Place 1 and Place 2, as determined in accordance with the Act, and conform to the requirements of Chapter 52, Texas Election Code.

Section 11: The following provisions regarding notice of the Election shall apply except to the extent that the Joint Election Agreement specifies that the Brazoria County Clerk shall provide said notice. This Order shall constitute the order for the calling of the Election and shall also constitute notice of the Election. The Election Agent is hereby authorized and directed to (i) deliver notice of the Election to the County Clerk and Voter Registrar of Brazoria County, Texas, and/or the Elections Administrator of Brazoria County, Texas, as applicable, not later than sixty (60) days before Election Day, and (ii) cause notice of the Election to be given by posting copies of this Order at a public place in each election precinct that is in the jurisdiction of the District. with said postings to be completed not later than twenty-one (21) days before Election Day (unless said day is a Saturday, Sunday or official state holiday and in which case it shall be posted on the next regular business day). Additionally, the Election Agent is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Order to be posted on the District's website (www.bdd4.org), during the twenty-one (21) days before Election Day. In all such instances, copies of this Order shall be posted in the English and Spanish languages. Further, the Election Agent is hereby authorized and directed, to the extent applicable and if possible, to cause a notice to be posted at the entrance of the polling place for the District's previous election, which notice shall state that the polling location has changed and shall provide the location of the new polling place, all in accordance with applicable law.

Section 12: The Election shall be held and conducted and returns made to this Board in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, including but not limited to, applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code and the Texas Water Code.

Section 13: The Board officially finds, determines and declares that this Order was reviewed, considered and adopted at a meeting of the Board beginning at 9 a.m., Houston, Texas time on August 6, 2024, and that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of this meeting was posted on the District's website (www.bdd4.org) and at the District's administrative office located at 4813 W. Broadway, Pearland, Texas, and was timely furnished to the County Clerk of Brazoria County, Texas, for posting on a bulletin board located at a place convenient to the public in the Brazoria County Courthouse and on said Clerk's or County's Internet website, for the time prescribed by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and Section 49.063, Texas Water Code, and that this meeting has been open to the public, as required by law, at all times during which this Order and the subject matter hereof has been discussed, considered and acted upon. The Board further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.

Section 14: The Board hereby reserves the right to amend or supplement this Order as deemed necessary and appropriate. The Board further reserves the right to cancel the Election if and as allowed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 2, Subchapter C, Texas Election Code.

Section 15: Unless expressly provided otherwise, all references herein to the Texas Election Code or to the Texas Water Code shall mean and refer to such laws as amended and in effect as of the date this Order is passed and adopted.

Section 16: The Commissioner and Secretary of the Board and the Election Agent are each hereby authorized and directed to take any action necessary to carry out the provisions of this Order. Further, the Election Agent, with the consent of the Commissioner of the Board, shall be authorized to correct Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" attached hereto to reflect any changes by


